

Her Honour the Honourable Janet Austin, Lieutenant Governor of British Columbia

- The Honourable Janet Austin was sworn-in as the 30th Lieutenant Governor of British Columbia on April 24, 2018.
- Prior to this appointment, she spent 15 years as Chief Executive Officer of YWCA Metro Vancouver, one of the province's largest and most diversified non-profits.
- As Lieutenant Governor, she has identified three key themes for her mandate: the promotion of diversity and inclusion, democracy and civic engagement, and Reconciliation.

The Hon. Ahmed Hussen, Minister of Housing and Diversity and Inclusion (Pending)

- The Honourable Ahmed Hussen was first elected in 2015 to represent the riding of York South—Weston. He has previously served as Minister of Families, Children and Social Development and Minister of Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship.
- Serving as National President for the Canadian Somali Congress, Minister Hussen worked with national and regional authorities to advocate on important issues to Canadians of Somali heritage, strengthening civic engagement and integration. His results-driven reputation led to an invitation from the Toronto City Summit Alliance to join a task force for modernizing income security for adults.

The Hon. Harjit Sajjan, Minister of International Development and Minister responsible for the Pacific Economic Development Agency of Canada

- The Honourable Harjit S. Sajjan was first elected as Member of Parliament for Vancouver South in 2015. He served as Minister of National Defence from 2015 to 2021.
- For 11 years, Minister Sajjan was a member of the Vancouver Police Department, based primarily in South Vancouver. He completed his career as a detective with the gang crime unit. As a member of the British Columbia Regiment, he participated in four operational deployments - one to Bosnia and three to Afghanistan.

Mr. Muhammad Asad Gondal - BC Muslim Association President

- Muhammad Asad Gondal moved to Canada from Pakistan in 2001. In Pakistan he had studied M.Phil in Soil Chemistry and worked in the government sector.
- Since 2017 he has been the Chairman for the BCMA Surrey/Delta branch.
- The BC Muslim Association (the Province of B.C.'s largest Muslim organization) with 4,500 members and 17 branches - serves the 100,000 Sunni Muslims in B.C. with life long services including mosques, schools, and burial services.

- Kennedy Stewart was elected the 40th Mayor of Vancouver on October 20, 2018, and is the City's first independent Mayor in three decades.

- From 2008 until 2019, Govender held leadership positions at West Coast LEAF and was appointed Executive Director in 2011. She has co-authored key reports and articles and speaks widely on crucial social issues such as hate speech, access to justice, gender based violence and systemic racism.
- Govender earned her law degree from the University of Victoria and her Master's Degree in International Human Rights Law from the University of Oxford, UK. She has served on the board of directors for the University of Victoria, Pivot Legal Society, the Coalition for Public Legal Services, and the Society for Children and Youth.
